The Dual Diagnosis IOP is designed to help a wide range of individuals with mental health and substance use disorders that may include: Anxiety Disorders, Cannabis Use Disorder, Alcohol Use Disorder, Depression, Bipolar, Nicotine/Vaping Addiction, PTSD, Stress Disorder, Opiate Use Disorder, Borderline Personality Disorder, Grief and Loss, Panic Disorder and more.

What can my teen expect during IOP?

- A warm and welcoming environment where they can feel safe expressing themselves.
- An interactive educational topic to begin the group, topics include recovery, coping skills, family systems, self-esteem, communication, emotional regulation, forgiveness and more.
- An opportunity for group discussion led by our highly trained and experienced adolescent therapists- this time is used to process and discuss whatever is on the minds and is a problem-solving, reflective, and empowering skill building time.
- An option for individual or family therapy sessions that can coincide with the group therapy.
- Psychiatric Services are available for those that may need to manage their symptoms with medication management.
